

Wedding Song Suggestions

Prelude: Mix of classical and love songs. Mix in hymns if desired.

Seating of mothers/candle lighting can be part of the prelude or their own piece. Best to choose a processional song or a hymn.

Processionals should have a good walking beat and a variety of good stopping points. These songs all work well:

- Pachelbel's Canon (Pachelbel)
- Jesu, Joy of Man's Desiring (Bach)
- Processional (Wood)
- Bridal Chorus (Wagner)
- The Joy of Love (Martini)

- A Thousand Years (Hodges and Perri)
- Marry Me (Train)
- Trumpet Tune (Purcell)
- Trumpet Voluntary (Purcell)
- Perfect (Sheeran)

Recessionals are usually more upbeat than processionals. These work well:

- Wedding March (Mendelssohn)
- Spring (Vivaldi)
- Ode to Joy (Beethoven)
- Trumpet Tune (Purcell)
- Trumpet Voluntary (Purcell)

- Hornpipe (Handel)
- I Will (Lennon and McCartney)
- A Whole New World (Menken)
- Marry You (Mars)
- Everything (Buble)

Unity Candle/Sand Ceremony can be any song. I recommend a love song such as one of these:
