When to Change a Harp String



The harp string should be changed when:

- 1. The string is broken or missing
- **2.** The string is discolored
- 3. The string is wound all the way to the neck
- 4. The wrong string type was used
- 5. The nylon wrap winds onto the tuning pin
- **6.** The gut string is starting to fray
- 7. The string has dents, fraying, or discoloration where the lever or pedal discs press on it
- 8. Reduced sound quality (dead string)
- **9.** Time Is the string too old and stretched out?
