

Choosing a Harp

What harp should I buy?



	Lap	Lever	Pedal
Playing position	Sits on lap, on stool, on stand, or attached by a strap to play	Sits on floor or may have legs/stand to bring up to playing height	Sits on floor
Range <i>(Number of strings)</i>	29 or less	26-40	40-47
Height	2 to 3 feet	3 to 5 feet	5 to 6 feet
Weight	Under 15 lbs	10 to 45+ lbs	60 to 100+ lbs
Moving	Very easy with or without a case	May need a case and/or a dolly	Need a cover and a harp dolly
Music Options	Great for music therapy, may need adapting or playing higher for some songs	Good for Celtic, religious, easy listening, some pop, etc. Limited classical	Almost any harp music including orchestra music
Cost	\$800-\$3,000+	\$1,300-\$9,000+	\$10,000-\$40,000+
