
Harp Regulation

Harps need occasional maintenance to stay working and sounding their best.

A *regulation* adjusts the *intonation,* or the pitch accuracy, of the note by adjusting the moving parts on the harp.







- A pedal harp gets adjustments to the pedal discs, the pedals, and all the moving parts inside the harp that connect the pedals to the discs and cause them to sharpen the notes. Pedal harps have over 70 feet of moving parts inside, all of which could break at some point and need repair or replacement.
- Pedals harps should be regulated by a professional harp technician every 1-3 years depending on use.
- A lever harp gets adjustments to the levers and bridge pins.
- Lever harps should be regulated every 2-8 years depending on use. The regulation may be done by a professional or by the harp's owner. You can find the instructions on the following pages.
